



HEALTH INSURANCE

Angers & Paris campuses

Health insurance is **compulsory** for all ESSCA international students:

- **Students coming from the European member countries** should provide a copy of a valid [European Health Insurance card \(EHIC\)](#) or the E111 or E128 document. This document can be obtained via your university or from your home country's health service.
- **Quebec students** should provide the SE-401-Q106 document. This document can be obtained via your university or your home country's health service.
- **Non-European students** must provide a health insurance for the whole duration of their ESSCA semester(s) covering health, dental cares, emergencies, hospital, repatriation. This document must be written in French or English.

These **health insurance certificates** must be uploaded when applying online on the Essca platform.

Moreover, students should take out a travel insurance covering travelling incidents (such as: loss of baggage etc...) and repatriation -if not included within the health insurance coverage.

In the past, non-EU students were required to pay the [French social security in France](#). This is no longer required. International students may apply free of charge at the Social Security.

However, students must be informed that the application must be completed online and information such as French phone number, French bank account details, birth certificate translated into French will be required to submit.
